SAFETY NOTICE for the Contracting Partners of HungaroControl Pte. Ltd. Co.

DEAR PARTNER,

You are about to perform work at a safety critical organization, HungaroControl Air Navigation Services Pte. Ltd. Co. The primary function of HungaroControl is to prevent the collision of aircraft flying in the airspace of Hungary. To support this, the Company operates a Safety Management System, which applies to everyone who carries out work for the organization, both HungaroControl employees and contracted partners.

The knowledge of the Safety Management System is expected from everybody, and this is why this Safety Notice has been made. Please, read it with attention. If you have any questions, please consult your HungaroControl contact person.

WHAT YOU MUST KNOW:

Your work must be done without causing any disturbance to air traffic control.

For this reason, the followings are very important to remember:

- The work must be performed by competent personnel!
- Perform the task that you are assigned for and in the conditions that were defined in advance. (approved starting and finishing time, suspension of work)
- You must know if the work may or may not disturb air traffic navigation services.
- Do not improvise! If you encounter an unexpected situation or you have doubts, consult your HungaroControl contact person.
- If you notice any irregularities, inform your HungaroControl contact person immediately.

You must have the up-to-date documentation at hand.

- You must have the documentation at hand regarding the given work, the assignment and the conditions of the work.
- If there is a change in the conditions of the work compared to what was defined in advance, make records of these changes or ask your HungaroControl contact person to do so.







If you think that the work can be performed with less noise, fewer risks or causing less disturbance in general, notify your HungaroControl contact person.

By observing the rules above, you contribute to the safe travel of tens of millions of passengers using the airspace of Hungary each year.
